PLEASE READ THESE TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

ONE CLASS HANDICAP, with handicap based on 90% of 210 figured on team basis.

Bowlers will use their highest USBC sanctioned Kitsap County B.A. book average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2015-2016 season. If average is from a SPORT league, the average will be converted to standard league average. If no average last year, use highest current USBC sanctioned average, 21 games or more as of Jan. 1, 2017. A bowler who does not have an acceptable average (21 games or more) under above rule may be accepted at their most recent USBC sanctioned league average and permitted to compete upon approval of the tournament committee. If bowler is not permitted to compete at their most recent USBC sanctioned league average, they have the option of competing at the scratch average of 210.

USBC Rule 319-a-2 DOES apply in this tournament (10 pin higher rule).

It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his/her team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game of the series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher. (USBC Rule 319-a-3). It shall be each bowler's responsibility to be familiar with the re-rating requirements of USBC Rule 319c.

A bowler who qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in cash or merchandise in any event in a tournament within the previous 12-month period, must report his/her actual score, position, and amount won to the tournament management at time of entry in handicap or classified tournament for possible re-rating. Such re-rating must be done before the entrant bowls (USBC Rule 319e). Tournament management reserves the right to re-rate any entrant prior to bowling. If the entrant refuses the re-rate, entry fees will be refunded. Entrants have the right to appeal any re-rate to the USBC within 15 days of the date of bowling or prior to payment of prizes, whichever comes first.

A tournament game or frames within a game that is irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be re-bowled with the approval of the tournament management. The decision of the tournament management is final unless an appeal is made to USBC (Rule 329).

Only members of the Kitsap County Bowling Association are eligible to bowl in the tournament. Non-members living within the jurisdiction of this association who are members of another association may enter by paying an unattached membership fee.

A bowler can bowl as many team events as they want by changing at least two bowlers.

Not more than 3 players on the same team can place more than once in prize list for position standing.

A bowler's first team score will be used for their all event total.

Each bowler may compete in Doubles as many times as they want by changing partners.

Each bowler may compete in Singles as many times as they want, but may place only once using their highest score in the prize list for position standings.

A bowler's first Doubles and first Singles score will be used for their all event total.

REMEMBER: Captains must present five individual USBC membership cards when checking in for Team Event. All bowlers must show their USBC cards when checking in for Doubles and Singles events.

No reservation is guaranteed unless accompanied by a completed, paid entry form.

Report all substitutions to the Tournament Managers Office at least 45 minutes before squad time.

In case of a protest contact the Tournament Manager at once.

Altering the surface of a bowler's ball by the use of abrasives in this tournament is prohibited and the bowler will be disqualified from further competition. (See Rule 18 in the USBC Rule Book).

Rule 328 applies in this tournament (changing hands).

Each team captain is responsible for his/her team in all matters pertaining to behavior, eligibility, line-up, and compliance with all tournament rules.

Prize ratio – one for each six entries

All Events ratio – one for each ten entries

Prize fees returned 100 percent

All-Event prize money is on handicap basis.

USBC Championship Chevrons awarded to handicap champions in each event.

\$25.00 will be charged for any checks returned by banks, credit unions, etc., and bowler will be subject to disqualification.
